PHC's new Women's Health Medical Director

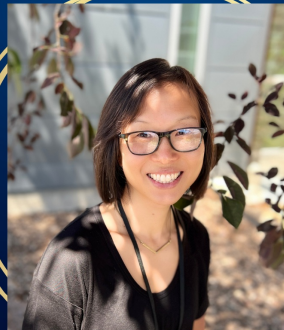
"It is to purchase birth control pills for our patients, as well as emergency contraception," Leining said. "So, we can actually give our patients medications directly when they come to clinic. We also use the funding to get IUDs and implants; all forms of birth control, which, again, our patients are uninsured and the costs of birth control, it's very expensive." The number of requests for women's health visits, she says have gone up by about 70% in the last year. "In addition to that," Leining said, "we have a lot of medically complicated patients and

Funding also allows us to hire an additional women's health practitioner to expand appointment availability for our patients and to continue our clinic's overall work. Last year alone our patients' need for women's health services grew by 70%. We are now anticipating an even greater need to provide and fund these essential services.
