As the CEO of the People's Health Clinic, I'm often asked, "Who comes to the clinic, and why don't they have insurance?"

The answer is both simple and revealing: we care for the people who make this town run. They are the ones behind the scenes—working one, two, sometimes three jobs—ensuring Park City thrives. Yet, despite their hard work, many of them lack the basic benefits that so many of us take for granted, like health insurance or the security of knowing they won't lose their job if they get sick or injured. As a result, many of our patients live in poverty, navigating a system that often overlooks them.

Every week at the People's Health Clinic, we hear the stories that expose the realities of poverty in Park City. We see it in the faces of our patients, in the challenges they face, and in the difficult choices they must make—between paying rent or seeking medical care. These stories remind us that health and poverty are inseparable, reinforcing the critical role our clinic plays as a safety net for our community.

But how do we ensure sustainable funding for a free clinic in a town that depends on it so deeply? The truth is, our 11,000 patients - this large uninsured workforce - keep our restaurants, hotels, construction sites, and essential services functioning. Our economy depends on their labor, yet our healthcare system too often leaves them behind.

Beyond the practical need, there is an ethical imperative. Taking care of people isn't just good for business—it's the right thing to do. Healthcare is a human right. The United Nations declared that back in 1948. And while our country may not yet have universal healthcare, I believe Park City can set an example for the nation—proving what's possible when a community comes together with compassion and determination.

Let's be the community that doesn't just talk about equity but lives it. Together, we can continue to provide care for those who care for us, ensuring a healthier, stronger community for all.

At the People's Health Clinic, we are committed to shaping the next generation of medical providers dedicated to caring for underserved communities. Our staff members have been accepted into MD, PA, and NP programs both in Utah and across the country. To further support their growth, we have established an Employee Scholarship Fund, empowering team members from diverse backgrounds to advance in their careers.

In 2023, we proudly became a teaching site for the University of Utah School of Medicine's Student-Led Clinic. Every Friday, we welcome University faculty and students, fostering hands-on learning while expanding access to quality healthcare.

At the **People's Health Clinic**, we serve a diverse community of individuals who have come from around the world to work in the **tourism industry**, contributing to the vitality of our local economy. Many of our patients have faced **incredible challenges**, including long and difficult journeys to escape **violence and instability** in search of a better future.

Despite their hard work, many experience **economic hardship, food insecurity, language barriers, low health literacy, and overcrowded living conditions**, all of which significantly impact their well-being. Many also face **workplace vulnerabilities** that can further affect their health.


These **socioeconomic factors create significant barriers to healthcare access**, leaving many without the medical care they need. As a result, **preventable diseases often go untreated**.

The People's Health Clinic is a nonprofit, non-federally funded, no-cost clinic providing high-quality healthcare to uninsured residents of Summit and Wasatch Counties. As a safety net clinic, we ensure that **financial barriers** do not stand in the way of **essential medical care**.

In March 2024, the People's Health Clinic was honored to receive a \$1 million gift from MacKenzie Scott's Yield Giving Open Call through a highly competitive selection process that included over 6,000 applicants nationwide. This gift allowed us to expand our evening hours, enhance our specialty programs, and strengthen the impact of our services.

At the People's Health Clinic, we provide comprehensive outpatient obstetric and gynecological care, ensuring that women in our community receive the high-quality, compassionate healthcare they deserve.

Led by Women's Health Medical Director, Tania Bodnar, MD, our services include:


- Prenatal Care Early viability imaging, aneuploidy screening, and coordination of delivery planning.
- Cervical Cancer Prevention & Screening –
 PAP smears, diagnostic procedures, and HPV
 vaccination to protect against cervical cancer.
- **Breast Health** Clinical breast exams, **self-care education**, and referrals for mammograms.
- Contraception Management Same-day consultations, pregnancy testing, emergency contraception, and long-term birth control options.
- **Sexual Health & STI Care** Screening, treatment, prevention education, and support for safer sexual health.
- **Gynecological Care** Diagnosis and management of **pelvic pain**, **dysfunctional uterine bleeding**, and other reproductive health concerns.
- **Lactation Support** Education and guidance in collaboration with **certified IBCLC nurses** to support breastfeeding mothers.

Our approach focuses on **education**, **prevention**, **and personalized care**, empowering women to take charge of their health at every stage of life.



SPOTLIGHT - MENTAL HEALTH

Comprehensive Mental Health Care at the People's Health Clinic

Recognizing the critical need for accessible mental health services, the People's Health Clinic launched a pilot Mental Health Program in early 2023 and due to overwhelming demand, it quickly expanded. Our program provides specialized therapy and medication management at no cost to uninsured patients, ensuring that mental health care is never out of reach.

Led by Mental Health Program Director, Linsey Broadbent, DNP, our services include:

- Anxiety & Mood Disorders
- Trauma Recovery Including support for survivors of human trafficking and immigration trauma
- Attention-Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD)
- Addiction & Substance Use Support
- Family & Relationship Counseling
- And more...


